Tommy D. Jarvis, age 67 of Afton, OK passed away on Monday, April 8, 2019 at OU Medical Center in Oklahoma City, OK after a long battle with cancer.

Tommy was born on October 2, 1951 to Norman and Geneva (Jones) Jarvis in Miami, OK. He grew up in Afton and graduated from Afton High School in 1969. After high school, Tommy attended Oklahoma State University and graduated with a Bachelor's Degree in Entomology.

After graduation, Tommy worked for the U.S.D.A. for a short time. He then went on to become a clerk for the U.S. Postal Service in Miami, OK and retired after 35 years of distinguished service. He also enjoyed coaching and he played softball for many years where he made

countless friends on the field. His ornery sense of humor and mischievous streak always kept everyone on their toes. More than anything, Tommy was a family man and nothing made him happier than spending time with his wife and children and grandchildren, who will all miss him dearly.

He was preceded in death by his father.
