Larry "Brent" Griffith, age 49, of Grove, OK completed his journey on this earth on Monday, August 10, 2020.

Brent was born on October 23, 1970 to Terry and Donna (Buckett) Griffith in Claremore, OK. He grew up in Grove, OK and graduated from Grove High School in 1989, as the schools first All State Wrestler. Wrestling was a passion Brent would carry with him the rest of his life.

After graduation, Brent went to work for the railroad as an Undercutter. On June 5, 1992, while working in Sidney, NE he was in a devastating car wreck that left him paralyzed and after being treated in Englewood, CO returned to Grove.

In April of 2010, Brent met Eva Renee Baker and on November 12, 2013 the couple exchanged vows. They both attended Grace Harbor Baptist Church. Brent never let his disability discourage him. He always had a positive attitude and enjoyed encouraging young wrestlers and assisted in coaching in the Grove Wrestling program as much as his health would permit. was a true Ridgerunner at heart and hometown proud!

Brent was preceded in death by his grandpa, Percy Buckett, his brother, John Griffith in 2012 and aunt Lorraine Bucket.
