“David and I met on January 21, 2012. He brought me a star trek pin and a beautiful card. It was such a thoughtful gesture and was an indication of the type of caring man he was. We found out that we had so much in common. He loved sci-fi and computers. We had the same movies and shows in common. We talked and talked. When I mentioned to him that I had an eye doctor appointment coming up, he insisted on taking me so I wouldn't be driving with dilated eyes. I guess I was hooked at that point. To have someone you just met take time to help you was amazing. Over the nine years we were together he continued to show me he was there for me. When I mentioned I was getting too old to reach the floor easily, a long handled dust pan and broom showed up. He ordered food for the cat. When the water heater failed, he was there to figure out what to do. He took care of the lawn mowing in the summers and knew how to do small home repairs. He took care of the grocery shopping. He did 99% of the cooking. He rubbed my feet and would massage away the muscle spasms in my legs. If he was staying up late, he always tucked me in and gave me a good night kiss which, okay, was all the time. It was rare I went to bed first. I was so spoiled. When the furnace went out on 01-15-21 during this negative degree weather, he stayed up nights making sure the space heater didn't catch fire ensuring that we stayed “warm.” (Thankfully when it “warmed up” we could pull the oil filled space heater in from the garage where the washer and dryer is so he didn't have to stay up at night with the not as safe space heater. It was cold but he could get sleep at night.) He had his faults and one of them was not wanting to get married. I understood he was hesitant to get married again. We did well being happily unmarried. The rocky parts were there but the wonderful, thoughtful, caring deeds, actions, and words will always be remembered and treasured. I will treasure the words he told me recently that “I was the love of his life.” Well, David, you were the love of my life. I took the chance 9 years ago and let you into my life, and I am so blessed to have had you. I don't know what I am going to do without you. You did so much for me.
