Dora "Dani" A. Miller, age 62, of Grove, OK passed away on Saturday, September 28, 2019 from injuries sustained in a motorcycle accident.

Dani was born on January 11, 1957 to Lawrence "Buck" and Bonnie (Minor) Tyner in Vinita, OK. She grew up and graduated from Grove High School, Class of 1975.

On August 13, 1994 Dani married Doug Miller in Port Aransas, TX and the couple made their home in Grove. She bravely fought a battle with cancer and won it 2 years ago.
