Halowene 'Hallie' Hoesli, formerly from Effingham, Illinois, passed away on Wednesday, June 17, 2020 in Wyandotte, Oklahoma where she had lived with her daughter and son-in-law for the past 4 years. Hallie was 94. She was born on October 31, 1925 to Melvin and Reesie (Field) Carpenter in Karnak, Illinois, one of six siblings. She grew up and attended school in Effingham.

On April 28, 1942 she married the love of her life, Fred R. Hoesli in Charleston, Missouri, and made their home in Effingham, Illinois. They were married for 56 years until his passing in 1998.

Hallie loved the Lord and was a prayer warrior. She attended the First Church of God in Effingham.
