Homer "George" Hutchison, 84, went home to be with his Lord and Savior on April 24, 2026, in Grove, Oklahoma, after a long battle with cancer.

George was born July 18, 1941 in South Fork, Missouri to Francis and Dorothy Elberta (Wright) Hutchison.

George grew up in Benton, Kansas and graduated from Benton High School. He married his high school sweetheart Peggy Hladik in 1961.
