Hubert R. Moore, age 72, of Grove, Oklahoma, affectionately known to his friends as 'Hotshot', passed from this life on Friday, February 21, 2020 at Mercy Hospital in Joplin Missouri. He was born on December 29, 1947 in Walnut Ridge, Arkansas to Hubert and Violet (Howard) Moore.

Hubert went to school in Rockford, Illinois. He entered the United States Army in 1966 and proudly served his country in Viet Nam. He became a Sergeant E5 Drill Instructor at Ft.
