James M. Glazier, known affectionately as Jim, passed away on June 25, 2026, at the age of 71, in Grove, Oklahoma. Born on September 14, 1954, in Los Angeles, California, to Arling and Lois (Bushman) Glazier, Jim led a life marked by dedication and quiet passions.

Jim served in the Air Force for four years, where he committed himself to his duties with the same reserved diligence that characterized his later career.
