Jan Howerton, age 73, Of Grove, OK passed away on Wednesday, March 13, 2019 at St Francis Hospital in Tulsa after suffering a stroke.

Jan was born on June 27, 1945 to Guy and Margaret (Godlove) Tuttle in Jackson, MI, where she grew up and graduated from Michigan Center High School.
