



## Juanito "A.J." Tax-Serfass

March 3, 2006 - October 1, 2023

Juanito 'A.J.' Tax-Serfass, age 17, of Grove, Oklahoma, tragically lost his life in a drowning accident on Sunday, October 1, 2023. A.J. was born in Norfolk, Nebraska on March 3, 2006.

A.J. had recently moved to Grove from Monkey Island, Oklahoma. He was a junior in high school at Oklahoma Connections Academy.

He was accomplished in Tai Kwan Do and enjoyed self-defense classes. He had a collection of Marvel comics and delighted in a variety of video games and remote cars. A self-proclaimed Mama's boy, he was kind, funny and selfless, and never liked to be a disappointment in any way. Cooking was one of his specialties, and his favorite was spaghetti and meat balls. A.J. loved 'fixing stuff' and had recently moved to a recreational lake development where he assisted his dad in working on the recreational vehicles.

His memory will always be cherished by his parents, Mary and Adam Nelson, and his two sisters, Nataleigh and Angelicyah, and many extended family and friends.

A visitation for A.J. will be from 4-6pm Friday, October 6, and funeral services will be at 11am Saturday, October 7, 2023, both at Nichols Stephens Funeral Service.
