Kenneth “Ken” J. Stewart, born on November 26, 1934, in Moscow, Idaho, passed away on November 8, 2025, in Grove, Oklahoma. A man of many talents and interests, Ken lived a life marked by intelligence, independence, and a competitive spirit that drove him to excel in various fields.

Ken graduated from Halstead High School in Kansas and went on to earn an engineering degree from Wichita State University. His passion for mechanics and engineering was not just academic; it shaped his entire career and hobbies.

On January 5, 1972, Ken married the love of his life, Frankie, in Miami, Oklahoma. The couple made their home in Wichita, Ks.

Ken and his wife, co-owned and operated a small airport, where he also worked as a commercial pilot and flight instructor in Wichita, Kansas.

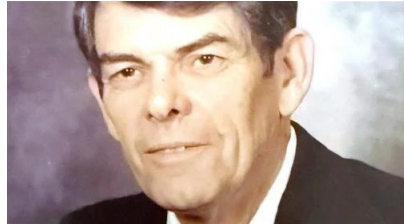
