Micheal R. Crockett, age 30, of Fairland, OK passed away unexpectedly on Friday, October 27, 2023, at his home.

Micheal was born on October 22, 1993, to Jeff and Darlenea (Self) Crockett in Grove, OK. He grew up in Fairland, and graduated from Fairland High School, Class of 2012.

An accomplished organist, Micheal was a member of the American Guild of Organist and performed at many churches including First Christian Church in Tulsa, OK, where he was a member. Previously, he was the organist for the First Christian Church in Stillwater, Ok.

Micheal enjoyed quilting and volunteered for Quilts of Valor to donate quilts to military servicemen. Fishing, traveling and camping were also some of his favorite activities.

Micheal had a thirst for knowledge, attending Northeastern State University for 4 years, Oklahoma State University for 2 years, and most recently, the University of Oklahoma Medical School in Tulsa where he was training to become a doctor for the United States Army.

Micheal was intelligent, kind and a genuinely happy person. He had a heart to help people and no doubt, would have been an amazing physician.

Micheal is preceded in death by his grandparents.

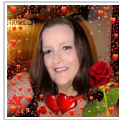

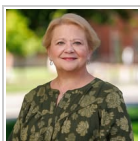
