



## Morayne 'Micki' Weeks

Morayne 'Micki' Weeks (formerly Micki Davis) passed away on January 13, 2025 in Grove, Oklahoma. She was born April 12, 1933 in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, the daughter of Edna Mae (Ditto) and Stanley Clingenpeel.

Mickie moved with her family to Muskogee, Oklahoma in 1937. She attended schools in Muskogee and graduated from Muskogee Central High School with the class of 1951. She then attended Oklahoma State University. Micki married and moved to Enid, Oklahoma in 1956 and lived there for 25 years. She returned to college in 1979 and completed her undergraduate degree in Psychology at Phillips University in Enid.

She and Jim became involved in the community and valued the many friendships that they made while living there.

In later years, she was fortunate to meet another classmate from Muskogee, Doug Condley. They became fast friends and companions as they continued this last part of their journey together.

Micki was a member of the former First United Methodist Church and she and Jim were founding members of Bob's Sunday School Class. She was also a charter member of Chapter GG, P.E.O.

She had an abiding love of nature and was always happiest outdoors. She loved gardening and took great pleasure in her garden and flowers. She enjoyed playing bridge, reading and sharing with her close friends.

She is survived by her beloved nieces Marianne Morgan, Elaine Akermann and Jan Lovelace, nephew Jim Shepherd and numerous grand nieces and nephews who enlivened her life.

She was preceded in death by her husband Jim, her two children, Vicki and Kevin Davis, three sisters, Genelle Harlan, Delmoine Shepherd, Necia Elliott, nephews, Cliff Elliott and Ken Harlan, and niece Peggy Harlan Talley.
