



## Vestena "Foxy" M. Emerson

October 26, 1937 - February 15, 2026

Vestena M. "Foxy" Emerson passed away on February 15, 2026, at the age of 88 at her home in Grove, Oklahoma. Born on October 26, 1937, to Bert and Iola "Bill" Waldon, in rural Ottawa County, Oklahoma, she was a cherished member of the Grove community and a proud elder of the Seneca Cayuga and Chickasaw nations.

Foxy graduated from Grove High School in 1955 and went on to study at Haskell Institute in Lawrence, Kansas. Her love for gardening and flowers blossomed into a successful career as she founded and operated "Flowers by Foxy". Her passion also extended to the golfing world, where she worked at the pro-shop of Cherokee Grove Golf Course.

On October 12, 1957, Foxy married John Emerson in Stevenson, WA and the couple made their home in Hood River, Oregon. He preceded her in death in 1986 and in 1995 Foxy returned to Grove.

A determined and caring individual, Foxy was often described as a mother to many. Her involvement with children extended beyond her family; she was deeply engaged in cultural activities, including tribal dancing and ceremonies, which highlighted her pride in her Native American heritage.

Foxy was a long-standing member of the First Christian Church in Grove, where she found spiritual solace and community. Her life was a testament to her love for her culture, her community, and nature.

She leaves behind a legacy of kindness, resilience, and unwavering dedication to her family and multiple communities. Foxy will be deeply missed

by all who knew her and will be remembered for her vibrant spirit and generous heart.

Foxie is preceded in death by her parents, brothers, Harold Smith and Tommy Waldon and husband, John Emerson.
