



William 'Bill' L. Bunn

William "Bill" L. Bunn, Jr., aged 76, passed away on November 15, 2024, in Grove, Oklahoma. He was born on February 19, 1948, in Fort Scott, Kansas to William and Willa Dean (Reed) Bunn.

Bill proudly served in the U.S. Marine Corps, enlisting in 1967. At the end of his tour, he enlisted in the U.S. Navy, and upon ending the Navy tour, he re-enlisted in the Marine Corps for a total honorable and dedicated military service of 30 years. His service included three tours in Vietnam, where he was wounded in 1969, earning a Purple Heart for his bravery and sacrifices. After his military service, Bill continued to work hard, applying his discipline and skills to auto body work and painting, both houses and cars.

Bill was known for his outgoing and friendly personality, a true people-person who dedicated himself to helping others. His resilience was evident as he bravely battled leukemia for four years.

Bill was preceded in death by his parents, and his infant sister, Concetta Lee Bunn.
